Drum Major Band Camp - The two drum majors and the band captain will attend a special Drum Major Band Camp to better prepare for the Wekiva Band Camp in July. Mr. McKee has requested that his two Color Guard captains attend as well. It was agreed that they would attend and to add expenses to the yearly budget.

Bylaws - Mr. Ferland shared that the band bylaws need to be reviewed, updated and changed into standard operating procedures in order to make them more user friendly.

Band Camp - In preparation for band camp, Mr. Ferland suggested that a short job description be created for volunteers. (Concessions, away games, etc.) These will be handed out and discussed on Preview Day.

Year in Review - The Board discussed the positive and negative aspects of all the activities that took place in band this school year.

Band Camp: Using the softball field for Band Camp was much more comfortable for the students this year. Although it was still hot, it was much cooler than the parking lot. It was voted that the fee for lunches will be raised to \$7.00. Students will receive a discount for buying their tickets for the week instead of daily. Bananas, granola bars and watermelon will be available for midmorning snacks.

Cheesecake Fundraiser: This year the fundraiser began during Band Camp and sales were due the first week of school. Next year, the fundraiser will begin the first week of school in order for the students to approach their teachers for sales.

Middle School Night: Due to poor attendance, Mr. Ferland has discussed making this night mandatory and the middle school teachers have agreed. Concessions will be prepared for a large crowd and extra volunteers will be needed to help set up equipment and chairs.

Marching MPA: This event requires extra volunteers, an equipment crew, chaperones, and someone to pull the trailer. Water will be brought in case the host school doesn't provide enough.

PRISM Concert: Having the students wait in the cafeteria until their call time worked very well this year. The addition of microphones to announce when the students were to line up to perform worked well, also.

Solo & Ensemble: This event will take place at Apopka High School this coming year. The band will not need to have buses as parents can take students to the school. A trailer will still be needed to carry percussion instruments.

Spring Concert: Having the concert on two separate nights this year worked well. It prevented the program from being overly long. A fee will be charged this next year. Parents will be informed in advance. It was suggested that all proceeds go to the Uniform Fund.
