Discussion:

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m.

Band Director:

Mr. Ferland shared that he presented the children’s book idea to administration and was discouraged from going forward. Administration was concerned that the project could possibly run into legal issues in the future.

Concessions:

Uniforms/Equipment:

Laura Thomas reported that the band uniforms had been sent to be cleaned. The price is \$7 per uniform.

Mr. Ferland shared that it was time to replace the drum majors podiums. Podiums should be ordered in February in order to arrive by Band Camp. Mr. Ferland will research the expenditure and report at the December Board meeting.

Mr. Ferland reported that band pictures will be taken after marching season and before Thanksgiving break. Leonard's will be taking the pictures.

Treasurer:

Laura Thomas shared the profits for the two home games. The profits for the Timber Creek game were \$273. Profits were low because \$1700 was spent to replenish concessions. The homecoming game grossed \$2353 leaving a net profit of \$1342 for the two games. She reported that this was a better outcome than last year.

Fundraisers:

Sue Henesey shared that the Yankee Candle fundraiser will begin Thursday, October 25. The fundraiser will run for two weeks. Students will sell from Thursday, October 25 through Monday, November 7. The turn in date to Yankee Candle for completed sales will be Friday, November 11. There was a discussion on whether or not sales tax should be charged. Sue will research and report at the November Board meeting.

Sue also shared that the Rotary Club calendars and Wekiva ornaments will be available to sell at the Prism Concert and in concessions at the final home game.
