Discussion:

The meeting was called to order at 5:40 p.m. and adjourned approx. 7:00 p.m.

Band Director Report:

Mr. Ferland announced that the placement of the band in the end zone during the game on October 2nd did not work out and he is exploring other options for the remaining two home games.

Mr. Ferland went over the agenda for the spring trip to Atlanta. It's scheduled for March 19 - 21, 2016. Approximately 170 students are interested in attending. The first payment of \$125 is due October 23rd, the second payment of \$125 is due December 4th with the balance due once all the costs are finalized. The cost of transportation is still being worked out but the estimate is approximately \$4,000 per bus, which will hold up to 59 people. The cost of the trip does not include the hotel fees for the bus drivers. The tour group will provide comp hotel rooms based on the total number of hotel rooms assigned and we will apply the comp rooms to the bus drivers first. Chaperones are needed for the trip, 1 chaperone per 5 students.

Mr. Ferland announced upcoming events:

Prism Concert - December 10th and 11th at 7:00 p.m.

Apopka Christmas Parade - December 12th

Concessions:

Concessions has been running very efficiently with 12 people but Jenn needs two additional volunteers to work the pizza cart.

Uniforms:

Band Shirts have been ordered and will arrive on Friday, October 9th. Uniforms will be washed during the week of Thanksgiving.

Treasurer:

Toni announced that we have \$20,000 in the account. Mr. Ferland mentioned that we have a few large expenses to keep in mind for next year. New music stands and new drum harnesses will need to be purchased before the 2016/2017 school year.

Fundraisers:

\$7,718 was collected during the first fundraiser with 40% profit going towards the student's band assessment fees. Delivery of the items will be the week of October 26th. Roxanne will confirm a delivery date (preferred date is October 29th) and Jeff will send out a message to the parents. Yankee Candle is set for October 16th. One more fundraiser will be considered and implemented prior to January, 2016.

The Athletic Department's 5K has been scheduled and the band will be given the opportunity to sell tickets to the event. The cost per ticket is \$25 with \$10 of that cost going toward the assessment or Atlanta trip fees for the student that sells the ticket. The event is February 6th.

Correspondence report:

Jeff will send out a notice to the parents asking for volunteers for next year's Board. It's important that we give the new volunteers the opportunity to work with their counterpart this year while we still have a few games left in the season.
