Discussion:

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m.

### Concessions:

Menu Changes – Debbie Eubanks presented proposed changes to the concessions menu. Bratwurst and chili will be removed from the menu as these were not successful sellers. Chips will be purchased for \$1.00 and cotton candy will be \$2.00. Sue Henesey will research and purchase a menu sign that can be hung and removed before and after games.

### Fundraising:

Cheesecake Fundraiser – Sue Henesey shared that there were 50% more items sold for the cheesecake fundraiser than projected. There was approximately \$6,000 in sales. Mr. Ferland will reserve the cafeteria for distribution to the students. Jeff Milligan will send an email requesting volunteers.

Sue Henesey presented two new suggestions for fundraisers. She has been in contact with the Apopka Rotary Club who has 2017 calendars for sale. The discussion was tabled for the October Board meeting. Sue also suggested selling “Wekiva” Christmas ornaments.

Jim Huth shared his idea of writing a children's book through Amazon. He suggested that it be written and designed by teachers (Mr. Ferland and maybe and art teacher). Mr. Ferland will discuss with school administration.

The popcorn fundraiser has been postponed until spring. The Yankee Candle fundraiser will take place October 24 through November 11.

### **Treasurer:**

Laura Thomas shared that students sold \$6,787 for the cheesecake fundraiser. Mr. Ferland stated that some older instruments need to be replaced and would be getting quotes for purchase. A suggestion was made that food trucks be at the Prism Concert to raise money for the band. The suggestion was tabled until the November Board meeting.

### **Band Director:**

Mr. Ferland shared that middle school night was September 16. Students from surrounding middle schools will participate with the band during the game. Goody bags will be made for the students.

### **Equipment:**

Dennis Cann reported that the sky light in the trailer needed to be replaced. He will order the part and fix it.

Tara Kueczynski shared that she is moving and must step down from her position on the board. Mr. Ferland expressed his appreciation for her services.

### **Correspondence:**

Jeff Milligan shared that due to the added charges for straight texting (where a text can be sent to all cell numbers in Charms, regardless of whether the "cell carrier" is selected), we will use the free service through the email portion. Via the email portion he can request email only, text only, or email and text. But note, using the free method a text will only go out to 6 students/parents who have "selected cell carrier" in Charms.
